

## **Peer Review/ Argument Analysis**

Students are divided into small groups according to one of the following propositions and then asked to write a summary rationale as to why and how they would use 4 types of arguments listed below. Students are then divided into groups and asked to assess each other's rational, logic and reasoning for choosing the arguments in support or opposition of the proposition.

### **The 4 Propositions are:**

- 1) Should contraception be available on the campuses of Catholic Universities?
- 2) Should more bike lanes be constructed in San Francisco?
- 3) Is Walmart good for the American economy?
- 4) Should food trucks supplement the USF cafeteria?

### **The Main Types Arguments of Include:**

Causal Argument, Statistical, Sign, Analogy, Metaphor, Experiential, Authority, Ethical, Definition

### **3 Questions for Analysis:**

Is the writer's approach cohesive?

Are the arguments sufficiently explained?

Do the arguments address the audience's concerns or objections?
